

KSRT Fellow Application

The honorary category of Fellow is bestowed upon members who have made outstanding contributions to the radiologic technology profession and to the KSRT. The category was initiated to honor members who were dedicated to the organization and contributed their time and talent to the profession. The first applicant was elevated to Fellow status in 1987. Each Fellow has documented a commitment to the advancement of the profession at the state, regional, and national level.

Applications must be submitted on the current Fellow application and follow the submission instructions. Incomplete applications or missing information/evidence will disqualify the application.

Instructions for submission:

1. Applicant is responsible for obtaining and including documentation as evidence to be considered for elevation.
2. All evidence will be verified by the Fellow Committee Chair. All evidence must be verified for the application to be considered.
3. Applications must be received a minimum of 90 days prior to the date of the annual convention of the year the applicant wishes to be considered for elevation.
4. The evidence must be compiled in the same order as it is listed on the application.
5. **The application and evidence will be submitted as one (1) pdf file. No other file formats will be accepted.**
6. **The pdf file will be emailed to the Fellows Committee Chair.**
7. The Fellows Committee will review the file and the Chair will email a letter with the decision.
8. Candidates who are being elevated are required to attend the annual convention and to attend the elevation ceremony.

The minimum requirement to achieve Fellow of the Kansas Society of Radiologic Technologists is 100 points.

Section A: KSRT Service must earn a minimum of 55 points.

Other sections earned points may total no more than 45 points.

No more than 50% of the total points in each section may come from a single category within that section. Activities or service not appearing on the Fellow Point Evaluation Scale or items without evidence will not be reviewed.
